Things to do in Lacock:

The Garden at the Angel - please enjoy our own cottage garden. Grab a book, have a drink & relax!

Lacock Abbey, Gardens & Woodland -

The Abbey is a quirky country house of various architectural styles. Visitors can experience the atmosphere of the medieval rooms and cloister court, giving a sense of the Abbey's monastic past. A stroll in the botanic gardens, orchard and woods is a must!

Walks - around Lacock there are a number of walks of various distances on footpaths or roads. Please ask a member of staff, if you would like some guidance!

Things to do - the wider area:

National Trust Properties - as well as Lacock & the Abbey, there are other Trust properties to see in the area: Great Charfield Manor & Gardens, The Courts at Holt, Avebury and Dyrham Park.

Market Towns - there are a number of towns in the area that are worth visiting, such as Corsham, Bradford-on-Avon, Marlborough and, of course, further into The Cotswolds. Please ask, if you require directions.

Bath - a city so beautiful and special that it has been designated a UNESCO World Heritage site. The rural city offers something for everyone: stunning architecture, great cafés, restaurants & bars, superb independent shops and boutiques.
